

## Life Starts at 72

Kimiko Nishimoto is 92 years old and an SNS star on Instagram. She has over 230,000 followers, and has had several <u>exhibitions</u> in Kumamoto and Tokyo.

She was born in 1928 in Brazil, and returned to Japan when she was 8. She worked as a hair dresser, cycled for fun, and got married at 27.

She was a "regular housewife" in Kumamoto Prefecture, taking care of her husband and 3 children. She had <u>no interest in</u> art, and didn't own a camera.

Then one day after she turned 72, her friend asked her to join a photography course. Kimiko said yes. After all, the class was being taught by her son and art director Kazutami Nishimoto.

According to her son, "All doors opened wide for my mother after turning 72. Before at home, she wasn't very funny." That changed after she began taking photos of herself doing some comical poses.

"I'm interested in many things," Nishimoto says, "and always try to take pictures of things that are funny. It's as simple as that."

To take her photos, Nishimoto carries a tripod, camera, and remote control. She has <u>mastered</u> photo editing software, and this lets

her imagination run wild.

Nishimoto likes to take her photos in the area surrounding her home in Kumamoto. In some photos, she looks in pain, half-<u>flattened</u> by a car. In other photos, she is happily flying through the air as a witch or wheelchair racer.

In one famous photo, Nishimoto is dressed as a fairy, floating and praying to her late husband's shrine.

"My husband <u>passed away</u> five years ago but even today I still show him the photos I've taken," she explains. "He was always so <u>supportive</u> of whatever I chose to do."

Kimiko likes to change her photos with software like Adobe Photoshop. With this, she can create incredible photos. Her style is <u>clearly</u> popular, because she has so many SNS followers, and her exhibitions are filled with fans.

Nishimoto told a reporter, "To be honest, I don't think too deeply about what photography means to me. I just want to try and bring joy to people. Taking photos is the secret of my happiness. I'll keep doing it for <u>as long as</u> I'm alive."

To stay healthy, Nishimoto says she is a daily cigarette smoker and drinks a tall glass of Bourbon whiskey every day.
